District and Regional Sport Trials – 2022

This year there is a slight change to the process of the students nominating for district and regional sport trials. Please read and follow the steps below to give yourself the best chance of selection.

- Check the Display Sheet which list the sports and trial dates which is located on the sports notice board outside of Orion. Alternatively, all the dates are listed at <u>https://sunshinesport.eq.edu.au/district-sport/our-districts/south-district</u>. It is a student's responsibility to see the school Sports Coordinator – Alex Machin at least a week before the trial date.
- 2. Students will be reminded up upcoming trials via school notices (read out by the CARE teacher in morning care class).
- 3. Only students who have a very high level of experience in their chosen sport will be given a trial information pack.
- 4. Students are responsible for registering themselves digitally using the QR code of URL by the deadline no late nominations will be accepted.
- 5. Students must present at the trial with the paper copy of the signed permission and medical form. No forms, no trial.

Please note:

- Some sports have a 'direct to region' trial where there is no district trials or teams these sports and dates will be listed on the sports notice board and can be found on the Sunshine Coast School Sport website as well. These will be advertised through school notices as well.
- Not all sports and all age groups are covered by the Queensland School Sport. Please be conscious of broad age group categories for some sports. E.g. Soccer is 13 15 year olds. It is unlikely that a 13 year will make this team unless they are very talented.
- As mentioned above it is the student's responsibility to see the school sports coordinator about their sport trial.
- Due to the delayed start to the school year school and district swimming carnivals have been cancelled. Students can still nominate their times through the school sports coordinator to be selected in the sunshine coast swim team. Please see Mr Machin for information about this.
