UNIFORM







This is your guide to the Clontarf Beach State High School Uniform Policy.

Wearing our school uniform helps everyone feel equal and included. It takes the pressure off having to keep up with fashion or afford the latest brands, so no one feels left out because of what they wear.

Our uniform also allows easy identification of students and non-students, helping to keep our school community safe.

It connects us, builds school pride, and lets us focus on what really matters — learning, friendships, and being our best selves.

The school's uniform policy reflects both school and community standards, while also ensuring compliance with health and safety requirements — particularly in relation to appropriate footwear.

When to wear the uniform

Students are required to wear the formal or sport uniform correctly whenever they are:

- At school or representing the school in any capacity.
- Travelling to or from school.
- Participating in any school-related activities, including those outside normal school hours (such as excursions, sporting events, or performances).

Years 10 to 12 are to wear the formal uniform every Tuesday.



FORMAL UNIFORM

Top: Green school shirt.

Tie: Year 12 students have a senior tie.

Bottom: School Grey or black dress trousers.

Socks: School grey socks with gold and green stripes, worn. Socks worn with school formal shorts to be worn pulled up to knee.

Shoes: Polishable all black leather/vinyl lace up.



FORMAL UNIFORM

Top: Green & white striped school blouse.

Tie: Years 10-11 students wear a crisscross tie. Year 12 students wear a senior tie.

Bottom: School green skirt or full length black dress trousers.

Opaque black tights permitted in Terms 2 & 3, under skirt.

Socks: White visible socks.

Shoes: Polishable all black leather/vinyl lace up.



SPORTS UNIFORM

Top: Gold, green, blue sports top with school logo.

Bottom: Green sports shorts with school logo.

Socks: Plain White (or black) visible socks.

Shoes: All black (or all white) lace up runners.

NOT PERMITTED

- Grossly oversized or undersized uniforms.Contrasting undergarments which are
 - Contrasting undergarments which are visible (white or light grey short sleeve t-shirts are acceptable).
- Any visible item not specified in this document.
- No jeans, leggings, track pants, active wear, tights or cargo pants etc are to be worn.




PERMITTED SHOES

- Sports shoes are either all white OR all black, lace up shoes.
- Formal shoes; all black, lace up shoes that can be polished.
- All shoes worn must be clean and well maintained.







NOT-PERMITTED

- Canvas shoes, skate shoes, hi-tops, open toe and multi-colour shoes are not permitted.
- Boots, buckle-over, ballet style or suede shoes are not permitted.
- Only all-black, lace-up shoes are permitted with the formal uniform, as specified above.







CBSHS JEWELLERY

Keep it simple

- Small plain silver or gold sleepers or studs, no more than 2 per ear.
- One flat ring permitted.
- One watch allowed.
- Necklaces to stay tucked away and not visible.
- Additional piercings or large gauges that can't be taken out should be discreet, clear or neutral.





C B S H S HAIR

Neat and tidy

- Hair should be clean and tidy.
- Hairstyles must be neat and conservative.
- Unnatural hair colours are not-permitted.
- Hair past the shoulders should be tied up for safety, hygiene, and practicality.
- Extreme hairstyles (mohawks, shaved patterns etc) are not permitted.
- ✓ Hair accessories (scrunchies, clips, headbands etc) should be in school colours or neutral tones.

CBSHS MAKE UP

Natural and clean

- Natural face is preferred, with no makeup.
- Makeup if worn, should be minimal/natural.
- No fake eyelashes.
- No coloured lipstick or eyeshadow. Clear lip balm permitted.
- Fingernails are to be a natural colour and short in length.







- The hat is compulsory for all students and all activities conducted in the sun, including excursions, outdoor activities, HPE and sport (where possible).
- It is strongly encouraged that students wear a hat during lunchbreaks if in the sun.
