



# HOMework CLUB

Many studies exist which show the positive relationship between homework and academic success. Despite it being such an important part of every child's education, finding time to get homework done can be a challenge for busy families. Homework Club is designed to ease this burden.

## When and where does Homework Club occur?

- ▶ Every Monday from Week 2 to Week 10 from 2.30 to 3.30pm in our Library.
- ▶ Every Thursday from Week 1 to Week 9 from 2.30 to 3.30pm in our Library.

## Who can attend Homework Club?

Any student enrolled at our school is welcome to attend.

## What will students do at Homework Club?

- ▶ Students can complete their homework and assessment tasks under the supervision of teachers and teacher aides.
- ▶ As well as their school-based learning, students may also participate in other activities designed to support their academic achievement and/or pathway attainment, such as Job Club.
- ▶ Job Club is a practical session run by our Industry Liaison Officer and the desired outcome is for attendees to know how to write a resume and cover letter. This occurs in Week 4 and Week 8 (Mondays only) and is designed to assist students in the creation of resumes and cover letters for employment application purposes.
- ▶ Students are encouraged to ask for help when they need it.
- ▶ Students are able to access the school computers during this time.

- ▶ Students can also use this time to read, participate in study groups (students who study the same subject meeting together to discuss assessment etc).

## Other Important Information

- ▶ Our school's normal behaviour expectations apply and students are expected to wear school uniform during this time.
- ▶ This is not an opportunity to socialise with friends. Students must be engaged in school work during these sessions.
- ▶ Our I.T. technicians are available during this time to assist with technology issues or questions.
- ▶ Students are to remain in the Library during this time unless they have permission to go to another location in the school.
- ▶ Students must always sign at the beginning of each session using the register found at the Circulation Desk. This is to ensure we know who is on our campus.
- ▶ We gratefully acknowledge our teachers who volunteer to support students at Homework Club.
- ▶ Teacher-Aides are also rostered on to Homework Club. Please note, we cannot guarantee the same teacher-aides attending Homework Club each time it is scheduled.
- ▶ A Deputy Principal is rostered on to each session and is responsible for supervising these sessions.
