(1) Provision of work materials for nine subjects plus digital licences. Note over the year a student in Years 7-9 studies 9 different subjects/electives @ approximately \$25 per subject (plus the digital licences @ \$119 per student). This covers all consumables (e.g. cooking , art).	
(2) This contributes to the cost of administering the Student Resource Hire Scheme which is approx \$75/student.	
(3) Care Program (Leadership, Personal Development, Motivational Speakers, Healthy Lifestyle Programs, consumables for classroom activities, planner etc).	
(4) All students are allocated \$5 per term for printing. If they use more than that they are required to pay extra.	
There are no fees for Years 7 - 9 subjects. Therefore all students benefit and are subsidised by the school ~\$100 per student.	
There will be costs for additional optional activities, camps and excursions.	
Instrumental Music does have fees, determined by whether a student hires an instrument or not.
