

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2017

Clontarf Beach State High School will receive

\$516,600*

This funding will be used to:

- Reduce the difference between the Clontarf Beach State High School Mean Scale Score and the Australian Mean Scale Score in Year 7 and Year 9 by: Numeracy - 15, Reading - 10, Writing - 15, G & P - 15, Spelling - 20.
- Improve Year 7 and 9 NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands by closing the gap between Clontarf Beach State High School average and the State average by increasing the percentage of students in Upper 2 Bands by 5% for each NAPLAN Strand.
- Improve Year 7 and 9 NAPLAN Relative Gain by 30% higher, 60% similar and 10% lower gains in scale scores, compared to similar students in the State.
- Support all of our Year 12 students to leave with a Queensland Certificate of Education.
- Improve our whole school students' attendance to 90% or better.

Our initiatives include:


- Targeted programs to address Literacy and Numeracy needs via our school's Literacy and Numeracy Plan, including the appointment of two coaches (Literacy and Numeracy).
- Provision of student access to Literacy and Numeracy resources and targeted online programs.
- Targeted programs for individual students to address social and emotional well-being.
- Provision of staff training in teaching pedagogy, data analysis, Literacy and Numeracy strategies, and leadership development.
- Enhancing staff resources to support senior schooling access to multiple pathways, monitor student attendance, and provide student counselling and support.
- Provision of appropriate alternative programs for students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Providing additional teaching staff and higher duties to lead the Numeracy and Literacy strategy (two coaches), support senior schooling access to multiple pathways (Deputy Principal Senior Schooling & Vocational Educational Training Pathways Officer), provide for smaller classes, increased in-class learning support and monitor student welfare and attendance (two additional teachers). | \$265,000 |
| • Providing teacher aide time to support the Literacy and Numeracy strategy, learning support and senior schooling. | \$61,600 |
| • Accessing literacy and numeracy resources for in class use including student access to on-line programs. | \$60,000 |
| • Providing teacher professional development and training including Teacher Relief Scheme to cover teacher absence and coaching. | \$50,000 |
| • Offering student support through additional counselling and welfare support (Youth Support Coordinator additional two days per week, guidance, counselling, contribution to off - site campus, access to alternative programs). | \$80,000 |
