“There seemed to be a lot of people who have moved to Toowoomba,” he said. “There were groups of nine or 10 people who got together and travelled in.”

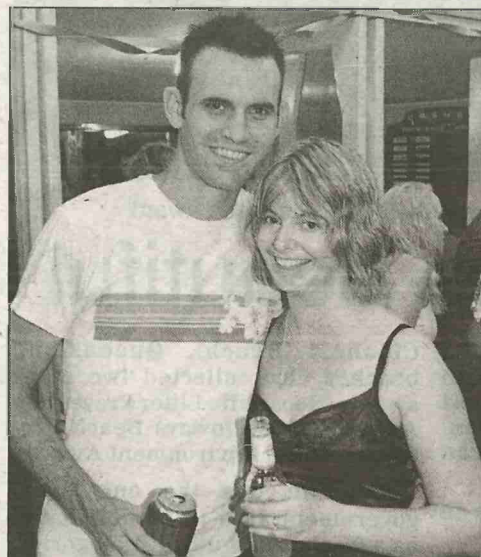
Mr Munt said that there had been many requests for another reunion. “Many said not to leave it too long, because we might have to dig them up to get them there.”
