Contribute a subject towards Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) for entry to University









**How does
Mater Education's
VETiS program work?**



You will start your VETiS journey studying a HLT23215 Certificate II in Health Support Services over two school terms.

You then have the option to continue study via our **HLT33115 Certificate III in Health Services Assistance** or **HLT33015 Certificate III in Allied Health Assistance** via a one-term gap program.





Start your journey here (two terms)

HLT23215 Certificate II in Health Support Services

Gain valuable experience in a healthcare setting and learn about infection control, patient safety, first aid and other foundational care principles.

OR

Health Services pathway (one term)

HLT33015 Certificate III in Health Services Assistance

Play a key role in supporting front-line healthcare workers as an acute care assistant, patient care attendant, orderly or wards person.

Allied Health pathway (one term)

HLT33115 Certificate III in Allied Health Assistance

Work in a dynamic allied health environment, as an assistant to allied health professionals including dietitians, occupational therapists, physiotherapists, speech pathologists, podiatrists and social workers.



Students completing the Certificate II in Health Support Services (HLT23215)

will be required to attend weekly vocational classes away from school (one day per week for two terms), and a compulsory workplace visit towards the end of the program.

Those who pursue the Certificate III Gap Program in Health Services Assistance (HLT33115) or Allied Health Assistance (HLT33015)

will continue weekly vocational classes (one day per week for an additional term), and a block of vocational placement.



Program learning consists of:

- + Clinical simulations
- + Clinical placement
- + Online, self-directed learning
- + Face to face learning

All training is supervised by highly qualified Mater Education educators and you will be matched with an experienced staff member for the duration of your clinical placement.

How much does it cost?

VETiS qualifications are funded by the Queensland Government's VET Investment budget.

VETiS funding allows students to undertake nationally recognised vocational education and training (VET) qualifications while they are still at school.
